MALDEN GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

- 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)** A ball is out of bounds if it comes to rest:-
Outside any boundary of the course marked by a fence and
a) over the white posts on the right of the 1st hole,
b) over the white posts to the right of the 13th hole,
c) on the putting green, walkways and flower beds surrounding the putting green, together with the car park.
- 2. Abnormal Course Conditions (Including Immovable Obstructions) (Rule 16) Immovable Obstructions**
Fixed sprinkler heads, staked trees, artificially surfaced areas and yardage markers are all immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under Rule 16.1 (one club-length from the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole).
Ground Under Repair
Play is prohibited from areas of GUR.
Relief is allowed only when the ball is on the putting green where damage to a green caused by vandalism, in any way interferes with a player's line of play, stroke or stance. Such damage, together with the drainage holes on the 8th and 11th greens, shall be treated as GUR.
- 3. Red Penalty Areas (Rule 17)**
Red stakes define all red penalty areas. Rule 17.1d applies.

ETIQUETTE

- All players are expected to play at a reasonable pace.
Please keep up with the game in front, "not just in front of the game behind".
- Green staff have priority on the course, a ball must not be played whilst they are in range. Please wait until you are called through. Players are reminded that at all times they have the primary responsibility for their own safety.
- After use, all rakes shall be placed within the bunker.

We expect a round to last no more than 4 hours.

The following timings are considered to be a reasonable amount of time to complete a round of golf at Malden Golf Club including a stop at the Roundhouse for refreshments:

- 2 ball - 3 hours 30 minutes
- 3 ball - 3 hours 45 minutes
- 4 ball - 4 hours 00 minutes
